Drooling or excessive saliva			
Mouth breathing/ open lips the whole time			
"Lisping" tongue between teeth at rest and during speech			
Tongue thrusting/ frontal lisp: tongue pushing out the teeth while saying /s/ sound "sun";			
/sh/ sound: shine; /j/: jump			
Tongue thrusting while drinking or eating snacks or lunch

Word repetitions: "I www want to drink"			
One- syllable word repetitions: "Go-go-go away"			
Prolonged Sounds: "Ssssssam is nice!"			
Block or stops: " (pause) come here".
